The Dunn School Health Office has been sending home via totes copies of the H1N1 Vaccine Consent forms that were filled out by parents for the 11/12/09 Immunization clinics. These copies are for parents' records. At the bottom of the form (under the "Staff Use Only Below This Line" designation) is the Home Health Visiting Nurses' documentation of the actual vaccine your child received at the clinic. This documentation will be needed for the booster vaccine that can be administered 3 weeks or more after the first vaccine. MSAD 15 is still planning on conducting a H1N1 booster vaccine clinic in January. The date for this clinic has not yet been set and will be based on vaccine and the Home Health Visiting Nurses' availability. Once this date is confirmed, we will notify parents and send home another consent form. In the meantime, parents who would like to have their child receive the booster H1N1 vaccine sooner may opt to do so at their own doctor's office.
