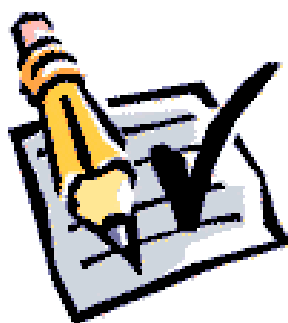
## **From The Principal**
